

# General Waste and Recycling Collection Service

The Mid Murray Council offers a two bin waste and recycling collection service to township rated properties and a one bin waste collection service to rural rated properties. General waste bins are collected weekly, while recycling bins are collected fortnightly. To see when your bins are collected, please view the [Kerbside Recycling Calendar](#).

## General Waste (Red Lid) – 1 x 140L (Township) or 1 x 240L (Rural) Bin



### What can be placed in the general waste bin:

- Broken crockery
- Broken glass, mirrors, ceramics, window glass (wrapped)
- Chip packets, lolly and chocolate wrappers
- Cleaning cloths and sponges
- Disposable nappies
- Fabric, linen, clothing. (check donation options before disposal)
- Food scraps (compost/feed to worm farm/chickens where possible)
- Pet waste and kitty litter (bagged/wrapped)
- Polystyrene foam (meat trays, takeaway containers, cups, etc.)
- Soft plastics (cling film, bubble wrap)
- String, rope, plastic strapping, netting
- Video and audio tapes



### What can't be placed in the general waste bin:

- Building materials (i.e. concrete, bricks and sawdust)
- Electronic appliances
- Liquids (i.e. paints, oil, solvents and chemicals)
- Garden materials (dirt/rocks)
- LPG gas bottles
- Hazardous/medical waste
- Soil and sand
- Hot ash (cold ash must be wrapped)
- Asbestos
- Large pieces of metal
- Recyclable materials



# Recycling – Township Only (Yellow or Green Lid) – 1 x 240L Bin



## What can be placed in the recycle bin:

- Paper, shredded paper (if contained inside a paper bag or box), newspaper, magazines, catalogues, etc.
- Envelopes & junk mail
- Cardboard boxes, egg cartons, pizza boxes (without food scraps)
- Cartons such as milk, juice and stock cartons
- Aluminum and steel cans and tins
- Metal lids (contained in a steel or aluminum can)
- Empty dry paint tins
- Empty aerosol cans
- Glass bottles and jars (rinsed with lids off)
- Plastic bottles and containers (rinsed with lids off)
- Yoghurt and butter containers (rinsed with lids off)



## What can't be placed in the recycle bin:

- Plastic lids from jars and bottles
- Garden waste or organic material
- Plastic bags and other soft plastics
- Car parts
- Tissues and paper towel
- Nappies
- Clothing and fabrics
- CD's, DVD's, videos or audio tapes
- Polystyrene foam packaging
- Foam trays and cups
- Crockery or drinking glasses
- Mirrors, light globes, oven-proof or window glass
- Toys
- Food scraps and packaging contaminated with food
