The big picture:

Group 1

Sports grounds:

- Cambrai and Sedan community owned land
- Need to allocate or support water
- Bore water, power cost and licence
 - → Maintenance, salty water
- Toilets impact on bowl
- Filtration system opportunity

Sedan Rec Park:

- In need of an upgrade → toilets, showers poor therefore people don't use them.
- Have camping/power availability but toilets and showers are a constraint. This could be a business venture and put \$\$ into the facility. (Cadell charge \$20 for powered site)
- Rotunda → white ant issues, posts need replacing, potential heritage grant, heritage value
- Tennis courts →No seating and infrastructure is aging
- Ground/field is weeds and cant afford to bring back →water cost is an issue. Bore is salty → look at grass type

Cambrai sportsground:

- Did try to make RV friendly \rightarrow could generate money through showers but would need to upgrade umpires showers
- Want to upgrade kitchen → meal (1x month)
- Old toilets → don't use but could
- Gym managed by football club → building could be a safety issue (already old equipment)
- Gym (Cambrai) could be a real community facility but quality is an issue
- Gold club in recess → lack of numbers
- Community does one step at a time
 - → Farmers, Harvest season
 - → Lack of numbers to do everything
- Young ones not taking on responsibilities
- Lack of 25-35 year olds that take on things to do
- Situation now has changed

Rail Corridor:

- DPTI nothing done
- → could look at opportunities in the future

- → Could connect to heritage trail
- Riding along highway is dangerous
- No signage = no paths in most of need to upgrade the heritage trail
- Potential community involvement in projects.

Reserve by the Marne River – Cambrai – The Bridge Reserve:

- Gets a lot of camping, no amenities, no designated areas, need defined spaces. Toilet, long drop getting busier → need to look at seating, shelter
- Look at Bolto Reserve, has all facilities now. \$10 a night


