The Upper River District connects to the Murray River from just south of Blanchetown to the northern most point of the Mid Murray Council area. The District includes Blanchetown, Mt Mary, Cadell and Morgan, and covers 2,393 km2. The population size of the main towns and their surrounds based on 2016 ABS Census data is as follows:

Blanchetown: 305

Cadell: 547 Morgan: 509 Mt Mary: 36

The District character is defined by the Murray River and includes significant natural and treed settings and cliffs, as well as developed riverfront areas and opportunities for diverse water sports, activities and experiences (boating, house boating, skiing, wake boarding, knee boarding, kayaking, swimming, fishing and other water activities). The tourism value of the District and particularly the towns along the river is high.

The Upper River District incorporates significant natural areas including:

Hogwash Bend, with a combination of Council managed land and land managed by the Department of Environment, Water and Natural Resources, DEWNR

Morgan Conservation Park, Department of Environment, Water and Natural Resources land managed by DEWNR

The Upper River District is closely connected to the Riverland and in particular to Waikerie east of Cadell. Whilst the river separates Morgan and Cadell, ferry crossings are provided at Cadell and Morgan to connect the towns.

Our Project Register

The Mid Murray Council Community Plan committed to establishing and maintaining a Project Register to manage and drive internal and external organisational projects. Regular consultation with the Community through project specific forums, feedback & meetings will maintain this register and indicate any gaps that need to be addressed. It will also allow a better understanding of project roles and responsibilities, eg, if it is a Council or Community run venture.
