



Mid Murray Council meeting update

Council held its last meeting on Tuesday 14 September 2021 at which the following items were discussed or determined:

The following were adopted/endorsed by Council:

- Approval was given to the Mayor and Chief Executive Officer to certify the 2020-2021 Annual Financial Statements in their final form when completed
- It was determined that the naming of the Mannum lookout will remain as is.
- Road and/or carpark closures for the following events:
 - Veteran and Vintage Motorcycle Club of SA Public Motorcycle Display at the southern end of Mary Ann Reserve, Mannum on Monday 4 October 2021.
 - 2021 Palmer Hot Rod Street Party, to be held in Palmer on Sunday 3 October 2021.
 - 2021 Ultimate Motorsport Event (UME) – Adelaide Hills Rally to take place on Sunday 24 October 2021.
 - The Volkswagen Club of SA car display at the Morgan Riverfront Reserve on Sunday 19 September 2021.
- Council endorsed the granting of planning permission for the construction of a private jetty on Crown lands, under Council's care and control.
- Council endorsed the future budget allocation and frequency for the Community Grants.
- Council endorsed the executed Murray Darling Basin Economic Development grant funding agreement for detailed design of the Murray Coorong Trail.
- Council supported the proposed structure and management of Council's maritime and heritage assets.
- Council provide feedback to the Local Government Association advising support for the fast commencement of the new Member Behavioural Framework.
- Subject to public consultation, Council approved a new lease agreement for the Mannum the Mannum Bowling Club Incorporated for a 10-year plus 10 year period.
- Council endorsed Council becoming members of the Energy and Water Ombudsman SA scheme.
- Council endorsed the purchase of permanent water entitlements to cover the water usage associated with the Mannum Waters marina evaporation
- The following motions with notice were endorsed:
 - It was agreed to amend the Code of Practice Access to Council & Committee Meetings & Documents (Electronic Means) and associated Protocols for Council and Committee Meetings by Electronic Means to facilitate the public access to recordings of workshops through Council's YouTube channel.
