NOTICE UNDER SECTION 33 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1961

I, Christopher Drew Holland, Senior Sergeant of Police, for, and on behalf of the Commissioner of Police, exercise the authority delegated by the Minister for Transport under Section 11 Road Traffic Act, and make the following order under Section 33 of the Act.

I declare that the **'2022 Adelaide Hills Rally'** is an event to which this section applies and that the following roads be closed to traffic **between the below listed times on Saturday 22 October 2022:**

Within the Rural City of Murray Bridge: -

Monarto Stage

- **Anders Road** between Patterson Road and Paech Road
- **Preamimma Road** in its entirety
- **Dishers Hill Road** between Preamimma Road and Wattle Road
- **Wattle Road** between Dishers Hill Road and Frahns Farm Road
- **Frahns Farm Road** between Wattle Road and Thiele Road

Between 9.22am and 3.25pm

Rockleigh Stage

- **Law Road** between Gogel Road and Panican Hill Road
- **Panican Hill Road** in its entirety
- **Critchley Road** between Panican Hill Road and 353 Critchley Road

Between 10.10am and 3.40pm

Within the Adelaide Hills Council and Rural City of Mid Murray Council: -

Blumberg Creek

- **R Hicks Road** between Terlinga Road and Hanham Road
- **Hanham Road** between Hicks Road and McVitties Road
- **McVitties Road** between Hanham Road and Number Four Road
- **Number Four Road** between McVitties Road and Burton Road
- **Burton Road** between Number Four Road and Onkaparinga Valley Road

Between 10.00am and 3.30pm

Within the Adelaide Hills Council, Mid Murray Council and Mount Barker District Council: -

Charlignate Stage

- **Harrison Road** between Quarry Road and Pfeiffer Road
- **Kings Road** between Pfeiffer Road and Burnley Road
- **Burnley Road** in its entirety
- **Teakles Road** between Burnley Road and Lewis Road
- **Lewis Road** between Teakles Road and Bell Springs Road
- **Bell Springs Road** between Lewis Road and Warmington Run
- **Warmington Run** between Bell Springs Road and Hollows Road
- **Hollows Road** between Warmington Run and Gladigau Road
- **Bloomingdale Road** between Gladigau Road and School Bus Road
- **School Bus Road** between Bloomingdale Road and Gladigau Road
- **Gladigau Road** between School Bus Road and Mail Road

Between 10.30am and 4.00pm

Within the Mount Barker District Council: -

Callington Back Stage

- **Back Callington Road** between Lakeview Road and Mine Road
Between 11.30am and 5.00pm

I direct that competitors and officials taking part in the '**2022 Adelaide Hills Rally**' be exempted, in relation to a road on which the event is to be held, from the duty to observe any enactment, regulation or by-law prescribing a rule to be observed on roads by drivers of vehicles.

I further direct that the event must comply with the following:

- Comply with all Motorsport Australia requirements
- All closures must be conducted by personnel with the appropriate Work Zone Traffic Management training and utilising approved signage.
- All vehicles participating must be registered and road worthy
- All participants must hold appropriate drivers licence and not be disqualified from driving or form holding a licence in any state.
- Participants are not exempt from RTA offences related to drink and drug driving.

I also hereby authorise the '**2022 Adelaide Hills Rally**' or its agents and contractors to install and remove, or cause the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of this event.

All works to be undertaken must be done so in accordance with the "**SA Standards for Workzone Traffic Management**" (which calls up the **Austrroads Guide to Temporary Traffic Management and AS1742.3**).

The permit holder must ensure that, a legible and complete copy of this Approval (as either a hard copy or electronic copy) is available at the event site at all times that workers are present and is immediately provided to an Authorised Officer upon request.
