Council held its most recent meeting on Tuesday 18 January 2022 at which the following items were discussed or determined:

- Final details of the fixed term loan arrangements for water procurement was received.
- Infrastructure & Field Services – Summary Report
- A report detailing expenditure and income over the past two years for Graham Claxton Reserve at Cadell was received.
- A report on a Feedlot development and the road network requirements for upgrade by the developer was tabled.
- 2022 Sounds By The River concert will be held at the Mannum Golf Course on Saturday, 9 April 2022 from 12pm until 9.30pm. A COVID Management Plan will be in place for the event.
