NOTICE UNDER SECTION 33 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1961

I, Christopher Drew Holland, Senior Sergeant of Police, for, and on behalf of the Commissioner of Police, exercise the authority delegated by the Minister for Transport under Section 11 Road Traffic Act, and make the following order under Section 33 of the Act.

I declare that the '**2024 Sounds by the River**' is an event to which this section applies and that the following road be closed to vehicle traffic:

Within the Mid Murray Council: -

- **River Lane, Mannum** from the Southern end of Mary Ann Reserve to the Bowling Club
- **Trewartha Street, Mannum** in its entirety
- **Wattle Street, Mannum** in its entirety
Between 6.00am until 11.00 pm on Saturday 20 January 2024
- **The boat ramp and adjacent carpark on Polack Street**
- **Mary Ann Reserve, Mannum**
Between 6.00am on Thursday 18 January 2024 until 10.00 am on Monday 22 January 2024

I direct that persons taking part in the '**2024 Sounds by the River**' on the above road be exempted from all Australian Road Rules relating to pedestrian behaviour on roads.

I also hereby authorise the **Mid Murray Council** or its agents and contractors to install and remove, or cause the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of this event.

I direct that the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of this event can only be performed by a person with work zone traffic management training.

All works to be undertaken must be done so in accordance with the "**SA Standards for Workzone Traffic Management**" (which calls up the **Austrroads Guide to Temporary Traffic Management and AS1742.3**).

The permit holder must ensure that, a legible and complete copy of this Approval (as either a hard copy or electronic copy) is available at the event site at all times that workers are present and is immediately provided to an Authorised Officer upon request.
