



## Mid Murray Council meeting update

Council held its most recent meeting on Tuesday 10 May 2022 at which the following items were discussed or determined:

- Monthly Financial Reports – April 2022.
- March 2021-22 Budget Review report was received.
- Council endorsed the following for public consultation:
  - Draft Long Term Financial Plan 2022-23 to 2031-32
  - Draft 2022-23 Annual Business Plan
- Overview of Infrastructure & Field Services monthly activities and project status for 2021/22.
- An update on the Murraylands and Riverland Local Government Association (MRLGA) Road Transport Strategy was received.
- Council endorsed the deferment of the 2022/23 Special Local Roads Program application for the ongoing section of Murraylands Road.
- An expression of interest has been received from an adjoining landowner to purchase a section of unmade, unmaintained road reserve. Public consultation will be undertaken and an independent valuation will be obtained.
- The 2022 Adelaide Hills Rally is being held from the 20 to 23 October 2022 across three Council areas.

For the Blumberg Creek Stage, R Hicks Road, Mount Torrens from Terlinga Road to the Mid Murray Council boundary will be closed to traffic on Saturday 22 October 2022 from 10.00am to 15.30pm.

- The Marathon Canoe Club has been granted approval (subject to the general conditions of Council's Major Event Permit) to hold the annual Riverland Paddling Marathon on the Morgan Riverfront Reserve on Monday 13 June 2022 from 12.00pm to 4.30pm.
- Approval has been granted for the Mannum Progress Association (subject to the general conditions of Council's Major Event Permit) to hold the SA Truck & Ute Show in Mannum on Sunday 12 June 2022 from 10.00am to 4.00pm.

The following road closures and restrictions will apply from 5.00am to 6.00pm on Sunday 12 June 2022:

- Randell Road, Mannum from William Street, along Randell Street to the southern side of the Ferry Approach Road; and
- River Lane from Trewartha Street to Wattle Street, Mannum
- Temporary Parking Restrictions – adjacent to the Mannum Riverside Caravan Park (for disabled parking)
- Council Facilities Closed – Shearer Car Park, Boat Ramp on Mary Ann Reserve and the northern end car park on Mary Ann Reserve
- Council endorsed the draft *Mid Murray Reconciliation Action Plan* for submission to Reconciliation Australia for review and endorsement.

- A report regarding the 2021/2022 Cambrai and Mannum swimming pool season was received.
- A report on proposed changes to Council's organisational structure was received, with Council supporting the changes.
- Council will provide financial and in-kind support to help with the demolition of the Mannum Cricket Club to make way for the Mannum RSL. The Cricket Club will relocate closer to the oval.
- The Petitions, Deputations & Submissions Policy was adopted.
- Council has endorsed a three-year funding agreement with Murray River, Lakes & Coorong Tourism Alliance for 2022-2025.
