The big picture:

Priorities

Youth: [young children, older children and youth (8 – 13 years and 13-17 years old)] Needs to be a focus. A place – Oval area/safe space. Half pipe is well liked. Mobile Skate Park is well used. Units on Tenth street – old netball courts > options.

Trails:


- History is River and Rail = connect the two
